the perfect pour requires three steps, and each one is essential to the beer tasting its best. your bartender first rinses the glass in cold filtered water to ensure the cleanest possible pour. the tap handle is quickly opened to start the flow of beer into the glass, which is held at an angle to allow the beer to flow smoothly and to create the collar or "head" of the beer. the collar is essential to opening up the carbonation and releasing the full flavor experience; it also prevents the beer from coming into contact with the air and losing flavor. the ideal collar is two fingers thick. any excess collar is cleared using the beer wand. your perfect pour is now ready to experience, savor, and enjoy...

### stella artois Belgian Pilsner 5.2% ABV

This crisp golden pilsner is brewed using the same recipe since 1366. Stella Artois is very drinkable while still enjoying a delicate hoppiness and true Belgian flavor integrity. \$4.75 Cherry Stella \$6.00

### hoegaarden Belgian Wheat 5.0% ABV

The world's flagship wheat beer, Hoegaarden's uniquely cloudy and unfiltered white appearance is mirrored by its one-of-a-kind taste - sweet and sour beer with a little bitterness, slightly spicy, with a strong touch of coriander and a hint of orange, perfect for warm sunny days. \$4.75

### chimay white Belgian Tripel 9% ABV

Chimay Blanche, with its typical golden color, its slightly hazy appearance and its fine head is especially characterized by its aroma which results from an agreeable combination of fresh hops and yeast. The beer's flavor comes from the smell of hops: above all it is the fruity notes of muscat and raisins that give this beer a particularly attractive aroma. The aroma complements the touch of bitterness. There is no acidity, but an after-bitterness which melts in the mouth. \$7.50

**lindeman's framboise** Belgian Lambic 2.5% ABV The flavor begins very flowery, then becomes very sweet, suggesting a heavy hand with fruit juice. In the finish, the raspberry like acidity and tartness of the lambic emerges. \$6.00

### warsteiner German Pilsner 4.8% ABV

Warsteiner Premium Verum is a pilsner style beer with a smooth, rich, full-bodied taste wrapped in a thick creamy head and a refreshing hop finish with no aftertaste. Warsteiner quenches the beer lover's thirst for a clean, crisp, refreshing beer. \$4.50

### ommegang rare vos American Belgian-style Amber Ale 7.7% ABV

This little brewery in Cooperstown, NY does an amazing job with Belgian-style recipes and a dedication to the brew rarely found on this side of the ocean. Pours with a creamy head and amber hued body. Floral, fruity, orange and rind nose. Clean caramel malt with dry fruity herbal and spice elements offer a great sophistication and balance. This complex, moderately full-bodied beer has a smooth and seamless finish. \$4.50

### delirium tremens Belgian Strong Pale Ale 8.5% ABV

Delirium Tremens is a beer of fine manufacture and was voted 'Best Beer in the World' by specialists in 1997. Conceived with three different yeasts it presents a beautiful color, blond and coppery as well as a compact and abundant head. The beer has a nose of wheat and barley with traces of coriander and orange. Full and round in the mouth it is also spicy, with a pleasant bitterness to the taste. \$6.50

### St. bernardus abt. 12 Belgian Quadruple Ale 10.5% ABV

The absolute highest in the hierarchy of St. Bernardus beers. A dark ivory colored beer with a high fermentation and the slightest fruity flavor, it is the show piece of the brewery. Thanks to its soft and unconditionally genuine aroma, this beer can be smoothly tasted. \$6.50

### gulden draak Belgian Dark Tripel Ale 10.5% ABV

Gulden Draak is a dark brown Triple Ale, which makes it an exception among the Belgian Triples. The second fermentation offers the nice creamy head, the full body and all the vitamins of the centuries old brewers yeast. It is a "thick" beer, that you can actually "eat" to adventure the complex taste. Gulden Draak balances a natural malt toffee-like sweetness with a mellow happiness and some hoppy accents. The aroma is round, sweet and reveals the 10.5 alcohol by volume. \$7.00

### piraat ale Belgian Triple IPA 10.5% ABV

Piraat is a wickedly rich and rounded brew that packs a mighty punch. The powerful glow builds up from inside. Deep golden with a subtle haze. Lots of hops and malt. Mild sweetness. Reminiscent of bread dough, spices and tropical fruits. \$7.00

**unibroue maudite** Canada- 8% - Maudite is a mahogany-colored, rich tasting premium beer that has a distinctive, complex taste. Because of the warmth it releases, this strong character beer must be served cool but not cold. Maudite has a typically Quebecois name that is reminiscent of the legend of the Chasse-Galerie (the legend of the Flying Canoe). Legend has it that a group of lumberjacks struck a deal with the devil to fly home in their canoes, guided by Satan himself, to make it home in time for Christmas \$5.00

**unibroue la fin du monde** Canada- 9% - "The end of the world" Triple fermented ale. From the label: "The excellence of triple fermentation through a blend of special yeasts gives this malt beverage an exquisitely robust flavor of exceptional refinement." We couldn't say it any better. \$5.00

**unibroue don de dieu** Canada- 9% - Belgian style strong ale meaning "Gift of God". The Don de Dieu was the ship of Samuel de Champlain as he was commissioned by the King of France to explore the vast inhospitable land called America. Smooth, rich, and creamy; slightly sweet with a warming mix of strength and full-bodied flavor, delicately spiced. Complex aroma of vanilla and subtle ripe fruits, lightly hopped. \$5.00

**lambic** spontaneously fermenting style of beer unique to belgium using wild yeasts and often infused with fresh fruit in the brewing process

**lindemans peche** Belgium- 4% - A golden peach lambic with a sparkling appearance and fruity taste. \$8.00

**lindemans kriek** Belgium- 4% - A sparkling cherry flavored brew that is smooth and refreshing. \$8.00

**lindeman's pomme** Belgium- 4%- Authentic apple lambic from Belgium. The flavor of a lambic is dry, complex, tart, and like no other beer. Added in the form of pure juice, apples contribute to a light body, a glowing golden color, and an aroma that is a bushel of freshly-picked apples direct from the orchard. \$8.00

**cantillon gueuze** Belgium- 5% - This enterprise is the most assertively traditional producer of lambic beers having brewed their lambics as early as the 1700's in a nearby town, Lembeek, from which the style most likely derives its name. They are dry, juicy, lemony, and tart, though not as aggressive as they once were. The classic gueuze (a blend of young and old lambic) is complex, zesty, and Champagnelike. \$17.00

**cantillon rose de gambrinus** Belgium-5%- The process to make this beer is identical to the one to make Kriek. When young, the Rosé de Gambrinus will still present its full fruity taste. Later on, the lambic taste will become dominant at the expense of the fruit taste. \$19.00

**3 fonteynen oude gueuze** Belgium- 6% - A classic blend of one, two, and three-year old lambics carefully watched while it continues to re-ferment in the bottle. Oude Gueuze is tart, earthy, and incredibly complex, but also as spritzly as champagne and greatly refreshing \$15.00

**saisons** seasonal summer style in the French-speaking part of Belgium. A sharply refreshing, faintly sour, top-fermenting brew

**saison dupont** Belgium- 6.5% - Saison Dupont is a classic Belgian farmhouse ale. This is a beautifully balanced, complex beer that has a refreshing fruitiness and long, dry finish. It is bottled unfiltered so it may be cloudy or have a slight sediment that adds to the rich flavor profile. \$6.50

**ommegang hennepin** Belgium-7.7% - This hoppy, farmhouse style ale has a champagne like effervescence with a crisp but light on the tongue finish. Similar to the Belgian Saison style, this beer serves well as an aperitif. Hennepin has a majestic golden hue. The style is called Grisette or farm house and is considered to be in the domain of the Belgian Saisons. \$5.00

**unibroue ephemere** Canada- 5.5% - This beer is a Saison beer with a "wheaty" feel to it released in 2000 as the first in a series of seasonal beers by Unibroue. Apple-Éphémère possesses a fresh apple aroma with reminiscent notes of "Granny Smith" and "McIntosh" a subtle flavor of green apple is complemented by delicate notes of fruit and spice topped by a rich white head. \$5.00

**duvel green** Belgian Golden Ale 6.8% ABV Duvel Green is a single-fermented, session belgian ale that every beer drinker would enjoy. It has a gentle hoppiness, soft carbonation, and a subtle, smooth dryness with hints of fruitiness. \$7.00

**leffe blonde** Belgian Pale Ale 6.6% ABV

A pale abbey beer with a full, sunny, golden color. It has a full-bodied taste and a rich creamy head. Like all the Leffe beers, it is a "connoisseur" beer that is easy to drink. \$5.00

**brooklyn ipa** American India Pale Ale 6.0% ABV

Originally a summer seasonal, Brooklyn IPA has been getting raves since becoming a year round offering in 1996. Garrett Oliver, a student of English brewing and beer history, uses English malts and hops to brew his EIPA in the classic, heavily-hopped style of the 19th century beers created for British soldiers serving in India. \$4.50

**blue moon** American (Belgian Style) Wheat 5.4% ABV

An unfiltered wheat ale spiced in the Belgian tradition for an uncommonly smooth taste. Gold medalist (white beer) at 1995 World Beer Championships, silver medalist (white beer) at 1996 and 1997 World Beer Championships. \$4.50

**labatt blue** Canadian Pale Lager 5.0% ABV

Crisp, clean and delicately balanced in its flavour delivery. A hint of aromatic hop with slight sweetness and fruity character. \$3.50

**pilsner** golden-colored, dry, bottom fermenting beer of conventional strength and flavor

**stella artois** Belgium - See draft for description. \$4.00

**wheat** brewed with raw wheat and malted barley, often spiced with ground coriander seeds and dried Curacao orange peels

**hoegaarden** Belgium See draft for description. \$4.00

**wittekerke** Belgium- 5%- The spicing is typical for the Belgian style wheat beer: curacao orange peels and coriander, but with more emphasis in the latter. Oats provide a silky smoothness, and that is evident in Wittekerke, one of the few wheat beers that still uses oats according to tradition. \$5.00

**ommegang witte** USA- 5.1% - Ommegang Witte, a traditional Belgian-style wheat ale with whispers of sweet orange and a touch of tart lemon. Soft and seductive, Ommegang Witte is this summery version of spicy intrigue and refreshing flavor. \$4.50

**weihenstephaner hefe** Germany- 5.3% - Nothing refreshes like this naturally cloudy wheat beer with its wonderful yeasty fragrance of classic banana and clove and its lavish toasty malt and complex banana taste. \$6.00

**sterkens white** Belgium- 4.7% - Pours and amber yellow with a strong head and is quite yeasty producing a lemony citrus taste that is eased by a touch of sweetness. \$5.00

**unibroue blanche de chambly** Canada-5%- Produced from an interesting blend of unmalted Quebec wheat and pale barley malt, to which spices and natural aromatics are added, along with a light hop. The blanche is only partially filtered so that it retains the full benefits of its natural ingredients giving it the cloudy appearance that was characteristic of pale beers in the middle ages. \$5.00

**ale** brewed with a top-fermenting yeast giving it a distinctive

fruitiness; ales have a wide variety of colors, palates and strengths

**westmalle dubbel** Belgium- 7.1%- A reddish brown trappist ale, malts and fruit, featuring a 3 week secondary fermentation that adds to the richness and complexity of this delicious ale. This is a deliciously malty, chocolatey beer, with hints of banana and passionfruit towards a dry finish. \$7.00

**westmalle tripel** Belgium- 9.5%- Originally produced in a time golden lagers were becoming popular in Belgium, and several brewers of strong dark ales were responding by experimenting with paler malts. High strength, ale-yeast fruitiness, and the types of malt and hop typically used in pilsner lagers, combined to make a whole new style. Westmalle Tripel has become a classic example, much imitated for its orangey-gold color; its combination of power and drinkability; and its complex of appetizing aromas and flavors. A freshness in the nose, from Saaz hops, herbal, sagelike notes, and an orange-skin fruitiness, are just some of the elements. \$7.75

**rochefort 8** Belgium- 9.2% - Slightly lower in alcohol to the Rochefort 10 with toffee and dark fruit notes while very balanced for its style. \$7.00

**rochefort 10** Belgium- 11.3% - The top product from the Rochefort Trappist brewery. Dark color, full and very distinctive taste. Strong plum, raisin, and black currant palate, with ascending notes of vinousness and other complexities. \$7.75

**achel brown** Belgium- 8% - This Trappist, bottle-conditioned, is brewed in the abbey by monks who use only premium natural ingredients: water, malted barley, hop and yeast. \$7.75

**achel blonde** Belgium-8% - This beer has a huge white creamy head, beige hazy color. If you're ever lucky enough to smell this beer, hops are the first thing noticed. Fruits, orange, perfume, spices, and all of that together with the nice aromas of malts and alcohol, finished with a perfect touch of the world-famous West-Malle yeasts. \$7.75

**chimay red** Belgium- 7% - Chimay Rouge (Red) is noted for its coppery color, which makes it particularly attractive when glassed. Topped with a creamy head, it gives off a light, fruity apricot aroma produced by the fermentation. The taste is a balance confirming the fruity nuances noticed in the fragrance. Its taste, which imparts a silky sensation to the tongue, is made refreshing by a light touch of bitterness. To the palate, the taster perceives a pleasant astringency which complements the flavor qualities of this beer very harmoniously. This Trappist brew is top fermented, and then refermented in the bottle. \$7.00

**chimay blue** Belgium- 9% - Chimay Bleu is principally distinguished by its character of a strong beer. This is a beer whose fragrance of fresh yeast with a light, flowery rosy touch is especially pleasant. Its flavor, noticed when tasting it, only accentuates the pleasant sensations perceived in the aroma, while revealing a light and pleasant touch of roasted malt. \$7.75

**Orval** Belgium- 6.2% - In contrast to all the others, the Orval Trappist brewery makes only one beer for the general public. It has an intensely aromatic and dry character. Between the first and second fermentations there is also an additional dry-hopping process that gives it an extra dry taste. \$7.00

**delirium nocturnum** Belgium- 9% - Nocturnum is the darker brown brother of Delirium Tremens with a more cherry malt aroma than its sweeter relative. Made with five malts, smooth, rich, perfumy. \$6.50

**corsendonk brown** Belgium- 7.5% - Has a very distinctive bouquet: yeasty, fruity and slightly smoky. In palate, it has notes of port, raisins and black chocolate. \$6.00

**corsendonk pale ale** Belgium- 7.5%- It has a very big head indeed, pour it gently, and a very clean palate, beginning with a dry, lightly citrus fruitiness, and finishing with a distinctive and delicate perfumed hop character. Very light and fluffy in texture, giving little hint of its strength. \$6.00

**duvel** Belgium- 8.5% - This is the "devil" of Belgian beers, as the fluffy head and mild flavor hide its strength. Four generations of the Moortgat family have brought together Pilsner malts, Bohemian hops, and a unique yeast strain to create this intense, aromatic and beguiling ale. The brew is extremely fragrant, and has flavors reminiscent of orange zest, pear brandy, green apples, and the lightest touch of smooth, stony dryness. \$7.00

**tripel karmeliet** Belgium- 8%- Blond, robust, smooth, and fruity three grain top fermented beer, refermented in the bottle. Brewed with pride and patience after Karmeliet tradition with wheat, oat and barley; 100% natural. \$6.50

**kwak** Belgium-8%- Full-bodied Belgian Specialty Ale. Amber in color with beautiful foam and slightly sweet, seductive malt character. Rich, satisfying Belgian experience made from three malts and a small proportion of white confectioner's sugar. It is malty, toffeeish, and nougatlike, with a fruity, brandyish, warming finish. \$6.50

**houblon chouffe** Belgium-9%- From the Brewers of La Chouffe, a unique marriage between the English tradition of IPAs, the new American revolution of Imperial IPAs and the classic Belgian way of brewing. Houblon Chouffe, or "Hop Chouffe," although very much hopped as it is, showcases the unique balance between a very strong IPA and a very special Belgian Tripel exclusively created for this ale. Big malty body, distinct dryness, expressive estery fruitiness \$8.00

**la chouffe** Belgium- 8% - A Belgian Strong Ale brewed by Brasserie d'Achouffe, Achouffe, Belgium. Golden Ale, strong, spicy, lightly hoppy, with evolving taste. Natural Beer, bottle refermented, unfiltered, not pasteurised and without any additives. \$8.00

**augustijn** Belgium- 8%- Full body, staying head, amber color with a spicy, malty palate that finishes very fruity with complex hoppy undertones. Quite possibly the most underrated beer on our list. \$6.50

**aventinus doppelbock** Belgium-8.2%- Dark ruby, glistening mysteriously, streaked with fine, top-fermented yeast, this beer has a compact, stable and long-lasting head. It has an intensive, typically top-fermented clove-like aroma. Features layers of malty complexity, balanced by clove spiciness, figgy, raisiny fruitiness, and Champagnelike acidity and sparkly. The palate experiences a gentle touch, on the tongue it is very full-bodied, compact and yet fresh with a hint of caramel. It finishes with a light and delicate taste of bitters leaving behind a strong, smoothly rounded, sour impression. \$7.00

**aecht schlenkerla rauchbier marzen** -5.1% - Aecht is old German for "genuine", Schlenkerla is the name of a famous tavern/brewery in the Bavarian town of Bamberg, and Rauch is German for "smoke." This style of beer is made from malt dried over fires of local beechwood. It has a smokiness from its aroma through its palate to its clean, dry, long finish. \$7.75

**maresdous 6** - Belgium-6% - A delectable blonde ale with sprightly fruitiness, soft malting, and a slightly dry, gently-hopped finish. A sparkling nose with complex flavors \$6.00

**maresdous 8** Belgium-8%- Traditional dark abbey dubbel from the same brewers as Duvel. Creamy foaming dark-coloured beer with a well-balance flavour of malt and hops. Want to try something different from the trappist dubbels...try a beer that tastes like a trappist in Maredsous 8 \$6.00

**maresdous 10** Belgium-10%- Dark blonde maredsous triple with 10% alcohol content is characterized by a fine, almost festive sparkle. Sour, sweet, and bitter flavors melt together harmoniously in a full fresh flavor with a sweet after taste. It's gastronomic bouquet of flavors makes this triple an appreciated ingredient in the kitchen. \$6.00

**grimbergen blonde** Belgium-6.7%- Ochre coloured top fermented Abbey Beer with an abv of 6.7%. The use of Gatinais barley combined with carefully selected hops creates a perfectly balanced, relatively light tasting beer with a fruity malty taste. \$5.00

**grimbergen dubbel** Belgium-6.5%- Double has undergone two fermentations, which gives this ale a chocolatey, toffee taste with a warming brandy-like finish. \$5.00

**la trappe quadruple** Netherlands-10%- The strongest of the special beers and also the most revered beer from this seventh Trappist brewery actually in the Netherlands. Its flavor is full, mild and pleasantly bitter. \$7.50

**ommegang USA**-8.5% - Deep burgundy color with a big, fluffy head. Complex fruit aromas with a layered sweetness (honey, then caramel, then toffee) with a hint of licorice and chocolate. A big, rich, abbey-style ale that dries out nicely on the finish. \$5.00

**ommegang three philosophers USA**-9.8% - Remarkable limited edition strong ale brewed by Brewery Ommegang in response to a home brewer's description of his dream beer. Realbeer.com the internet's largest beer website, hosted a contest called "Create a Great Beer." Brewery Ommegang was chosen by Realbeer.com to brew the Belgian-style ale for the winning essayist. Noel Blake, a home brewer, from Portland wrote the winning description of what his dream beer would be like and this fine ale was the result...maybe you'll find it's your dream beer as well! \$6.50

**kasteel rouge** Belgium-8%- Castle Rouges unique dark red color is obtained by mixing kasteel brown that has been left to mature for at least six months with sour cherries. A great replacement beer for the Redbach ale. \$7.00

**duchesse de bourgogne** Belgium - 6.2%- "Duchesse" is the traditional top fermented reddish-brown ale from the West-Flanders region of Belgium. This refined ale also known as "The Burgundies of Belgium" is a blend of 8 and 18 month old ales following careful maturation in oak casks. 100% natural and unpasteurized. \$6.50
